### **THEY WILL ASPHALT ROAD LINKING THREE MINING CENTRES**

The company PSA was awarded the asphaltting of a 100 kilometre stretch of road which links to the mining regions of Huanuni, Bombo (of the department of Oruro) and Llallagua, Potosi.

According to the report of the Ministry of Mining and Metallurgy the work is considered of great importance for the region and should be completed by June this year.

The route is part of Jaime Mendoza diagonal road that links Muyupampa in the Chaco of Chuquisaca, border with Paraguay, and passes through Uncía, Llallagua, Huanuni and Oruro, to get to port of Matarani in Peru.

The Ministry of Mines helped to develop the project, because it recognizes the importance of the work for mining activities in both regions.

The asphaltting agreement establishes that the Huanuni mining company will disassemble, move, relocate and reassemble again mining equipment and machinery installed in the area where the pavement of the new route will pass.

The cost of all the work was estimated in 304 thousand dollars which will be disbursed by the Prefecture of Oruro.
